— Architecture principle

Four Pillars of the Vinkius Runtime

01 — Security by design

Credentials stay encrypted at rest via AES-256. The AI agent never touches raw keys — they're injected into a sandboxed V8 isolate at runtime. Actions are logged, and connections have an emergency kill switch.

03 — Deterministic observability

Eight immutable metrics per endpoint: request volume, p95 latency, error rate, active connections, cost attribution. A live payload feed logs every tool call with mutation detection.

02 — Built on MCP Fusion

This MCP server was built with **MCP Fusion**, the open-source framework (Apache 2.0) that powers the entire Vinkius catalog. Schema-as-firewall strips undeclared fields, compiled PII redaction runs at zero overhead, and cryptographic lockfiles produce git-diffable audit trails.

04 — Autonomous operations

Servers are deployed, monitored, and patched autonomously. New capabilities and security patches ship weekly. Zero-downtime deployments ensure continuous availability across all managed MCP servers.

Every MCP server on Vinkius is accessed through a **Connection Token**. Tokens are generated in the cloud dashboard and produce a unique MCP endpoint URL. Paste this URL into any MCP-compatible client — no SDK required.

A single token can serve **multiple AI clients simultaneously**, or you can issue separate tokens per client for granular access control. Each token tracks its own request count, last activity timestamp, and can be individually enabled or revoked.

Security Is the Architecture

Security in Vinkius is not a feature — it's the foundation of the runtime. The gateway enforces multiple independent protection layers between AI agents and third-party APIs.

01 — Ed25519 PKI Vault

Every workspace has an Ed25519 Master Key. Session keys are generated ephemerally (24h TTL) and signed by the Master Key. Credentials never leave the vault boundary.

02 — V8 Isolate Sandboxing

Tool code runs inside isolated-vm V8 isolates with 64 MB memory caps and per-request timeouts. No filesystem access, no network access except through the SSRF-guarded fetch bridge.

03 — SSRF Guard

All outbound HTTP requests are DNS-resolved and validated before execution. Private IP ranges (10.x, 172.16-31.x, 192.168.x, AWS metadata 169.254.x) are blocked at the network layer.

05 — Cryptographic Audit Trail

Every request is signed into a SHA-256 hash chain with Ed25519 signatures. Events form a tamper-proof, SIEM-exportable forensic record.

04 — DLP & PII Redaction

A ResponseGuard pipeline intercepts every tool response. Configurable redaction patterns strip sensitive fields (emails, SSNs, card numbers) before data reaches the AI agent.

06 — Honeypot Trap System

Phantom credentials are injected into isolated environments. If a honeypot is used outside Vinkius infrastructure, the server is quarantined instantly.

Emergency Kill Switch

The kill switch is an **emergency halt** mechanism — not a simple toggle. When triggered, it executes three actions atomically:

01 — Server deactivated

The MCP server is immediately taken offline across the entire cluster.

02 — All tokens revoked

Every connection token is invalidated. Total lockout — reconnection blocked until new tokens are issued.

03 — WebSocket connections killed

Active connections terminated via Redis pubsub broadcast. Propagates to every runtime node in the cluster.

You can start by using it to build a specific checklist for a new export, ensuring you've noted the destination and the person requesting the move. Before you even start the transfer, you can have your agent check if the requester actually has the right permissions for that specific service. Once the data is moved, the MCP helps you close the loop. It generates a receipt checklist so you can verify that the file arrived intact, checking things like record counts and checksums to prove nothing was lost or changed in transit. It's a way to turn messy, manual data moves into a repeatable, verifiable process that stays organized in a single overview.

Patterns to Avoid

Skipping the planning phase

❌ AVOID

You start moving a massive dataset immediately after a request comes in without documenting the destination or the requester.

✓ INSTEAD

Use ``generate_request_checklist`` first to build a structured plan that captures all necessary export parameters.

Assuming user permissions are valid

❌ AVOID

You process a data export for a new employee because they sent an email request, even though they don't have access to that specific service.

✓ INSTEAD

Run ``validate_authorization`` to confirm the user actually has the rights to access that service before you touch any data.

Ignoring post-transfer verification

❌ AVOID

The transfer finishes and you assume everything is fine without checking if the file is corrupted or incomplete.

✓ INSTEAD

Have your agent use `generate\_receipt\_checklist` to create specific steps for verifying record counts and checksums.

The Right Fit

Connect this MCP if your team handles sensitive data moves that require a verifiable audit trail. If your data transfers are low-risk, public, or don't require any formal documentation, you don't need this. The deciding factor is whether you need to prove to an auditor that your data stayed intact and authorized.

#	TOOL	DESCRIPTION
01	generate_request_checklist	This tool builds a detailed checklist for a single service export based on the parameters you provide.
02	summarize_all_requests	This tool gives your agent a high-level view of every pending and completed export task.
03	validate_authorization	This tool checks if a specific user has the permission to request data from a given service.
04	generate_receipt_checklist	This tool creates the specific verification steps needed to confirm an export was successful and the data is untampered.
