Four Pillars of the Vinkius Runtime

01 — Security by design

Credentials stay encrypted at rest via AES-256. The AI agent never touches raw keys — they're injected into a sandboxed V8 isolate at runtime. Actions are logged, and connections have an emergency kill switch.

03 — Deterministic observability

Eight immutable metrics per endpoint: request volume, p95 latency, error rate, active connections, cost attribution. A live payload feed logs every tool call with mutation detection.

02 — Built on MCP Fusion

This MCP server was built with **MCP Fusion**, the open-source framework (Apache 2.0) that powers the entire Vinkius catalog. Schema-as-firewall strips undeclared fields, compiled PII redaction runs at zero overhead, and cryptographic lockfiles produce git-diffable audit trails.

04 — Autonomous operations

Servers are deployed, monitored, and patched autonomously. New capabilities and security patches ship weekly. Zero-downtime deployments ensure continuous availability across all managed MCP servers.

Every MCP server on Vinkius is accessed through a **Connection Token**. Tokens are generated in the cloud dashboard and produce a unique MCP endpoint URL. Paste this URL into any MCP-compatible client — no SDK required.

A single token can serve **multiple AI clients simultaneously**, or you can issue separate tokens per client for granular access control. Each token tracks its own request count, last activity timestamp, and can be individually enabled or revoked.

Security Is the Architecture

Security in Vinkius is not a feature — it's the foundation of the runtime. The gateway enforces multiple independent protection layers between AI agents and third-party APIs.

01 — Ed25519 PKI Vault

Every workspace has an Ed25519 Master Key. Session keys are generated ephemerally (24h TTL) and signed by the Master Key. Credentials never leave the vault boundary.

02 — V8 Isolate Sandboxing

Tool code runs inside isolated-vm V8 isolates with 64 MB memory caps and per-request timeouts. No filesystem access, no network access except through the SSRF-guarded fetch bridge.

03 — SSRF Guard

All outbound HTTP requests are DNS-resolved and validated before execution. Private IP ranges (10.x, 172.16-31.x, 192.168.x, AWS metadata 169.254.x) are blocked at the network layer.

05 — Cryptographic Audit Trail

Every request is signed into a SHA-256 hash chain with Ed25519 signatures. Events form a tamper-proof, SIEM-exportable forensic record.

04 — DLP & PII Redaction

A ResponseGuard pipeline intercepts every tool response. Configurable redaction patterns strip sensitive fields (emails, SSNs, card numbers) before data reaches the AI agent.

06 — Honeypot Trap System

Phantom credentials are injected into isolated environments. If a honeypot is used outside Vinkius infrastructure, the server is quarantined instantly.

Emergency Kill Switch

The kill switch is an **emergency halt** mechanism — not a simple toggle. When triggered, it executes three actions atomically:

01 — Server deactivated

The MCP server is immediately taken offline across the entire cluster.

02 — All tokens revoked

Every connection token is invalidated. Total lockout — reconnection blocked until new tokens are issued.

03 — WebSocket connections killed

Active connections terminated via Redis pubsub broadcast. Propagates to every runtime node in the cluster.

Reaching out to a company that hasn't won a contract in three years.

✓ INSTEAD

Monitor `new\_budget\_triggers` to find companies that just started performing on new contracts.

The Right Fit

Palantir is a proven federal vendor with 47 recently modified contract awards totaling \$1.9B. They serve agencies including the Department of Defense, Department of the Army, Department of the Air Force, and NASA, with a NAICS mix of 541511 and 541519.

Frequently Asked Questions

01 Do I need an API key to use this MCP?

No. This MCP uses the public federal spending database through an open API that requires no keys or accounts.

02 Which AI clients can use this MCP?

You can use this MCP with any MCP-compatible client, including Claude, Cursor, Windsurf, and VS Code.

03 How fresh is the contract data?

The MCP can access recently modified awards and new budget triggers to provide the most current information available in the public database.

04 Can I find specific details about a single contract?

Yes. If you have an award ID, you can use the award detail tool to get the recipient, amount, agency, and description.

05 How do I know if a company is a good target?

You can use the company federal footprint tool to see their total dollars, agencies served, and NAICS mix to confirm they meet your ICP criteria.

06 Do I need an API key or an account?

No. The federal government publishes its own contract spending data through an open API with no credentials — the same data behind the national contract-expenditure site. There is nothing to issue, rotate or store.

07 What counts as a "new budget" trigger?

An award whose performance period just started and that was modified inside your freshness window (default 30 days). The recipient took new money: new scope, new teams, new tooling decisions. Filter by minimum amount to keep only deals big enough to matter, and by NAICS or agency to focus a vertical.

08 Why do rankings and totals sometimes look partial?

The open API exposes a ranked, paged view rather than a server-side census per company, so every aggregation works over the most recently modified matching awards in the slice you asked for. The result says how many awards it scanned, and a longer window or deeper paging gives a fuller picture. That is documented in each result, never silently assumed.

09 How is the public source protected from repeated scans?

Each distinct query is cached in memory for one hour, so re-asking the same question minutes apart costs nothing upstream. If the source rate-limits, the error tells you to vary the query or try again later instead of hammering in a loop.
