— Architecture principle

Four Pillars of the Vinkius Runtime

01 — Security by design

Credentials stay encrypted at rest via AES-256. The AI agent never touches raw keys — they're injected into a sandboxed V8 isolate at runtime. Actions are logged, and connections have an emergency kill switch.

03 — Deterministic observability

Eight immutable metrics per endpoint: request volume, p95 latency, error rate, active connections, cost attribution. A live payload feed logs every tool call with mutation detection.

02 — Built on MCP Fusion

This MCP server was built with **MCP Fusion**, the open-source framework (Apache 2.0) that powers the entire Vinkius catalog. Schema-as-firewall strips undeclared fields, compiled PII redaction runs at zero overhead, and cryptographic lockfiles produce git-diffable audit trails.

04 — Autonomous operations

Servers are deployed, monitored, and patched autonomously. New capabilities and security patches ship weekly. Zero-downtime deployments ensure continuous availability across all managed MCP servers.

One Token. Instant Access.

Every MCP server on Vinkius is accessed through a **Connection Token**. Tokens are generated in the cloud dashboard and produce a unique MCP endpoint URL. Paste this URL into any MCP-compatible client — no SDK required.

A single token can serve **multiple AI clients simultaneously**, or you can issue separate tokens per client for granular access control. Each token tracks its own request count, last activity timestamp, and can be individually enabled or revoked.

Security Is the Architecture

Security in Vinkius is not a feature — it's the foundation of the runtime. The gateway enforces multiple independent protection layers between AI agents and third-party APIs.

01 — Ed25519 PKI Vault

Every workspace has an Ed25519 Master Key. Session keys are generated ephemerally (24h TTL) and signed by the Master Key. Credentials never leave the vault boundary.

02 — V8 Isolate Sandboxing

Tool code runs inside isolated-vm V8 isolates with 64 MB memory caps and per-request timeouts. No filesystem access, no network access except through the SSRF-guarded fetch bridge.

03 — SSRF Guard

All outbound HTTP requests are DNS-resolved and validated before execution. Private IP ranges (10.x, 172.16-31.x, 192.168.x, AWS metadata 169.254.x) are blocked at the network layer.

05 — Cryptographic Audit Trail

Every request is signed into a SHA-256 hash chain with Ed25519 signatures. Events form a tamper-proof, SIEM-exportable forensic record.

04 — DLP & PII Redaction

A ResponseGuard pipeline intercepts every tool response. Configurable redaction patterns strip sensitive fields (emails, SSNs, card numbers) before data reaches the AI agent.

06 — Honeytoken Trap System

Phantom credentials are injected into isolated environments. If a honeytoken is used outside Vinkius infrastructure, the server is quarantined instantly.

Emergency Kill Switch

EU AI Act Art. 14(1)
Compliant

The kill switch is an **emergency halt** mechanism — not a simple toggle. When triggered, it executes three actions atomically:

01 — Server deactivated

The MCP server is immediately taken offline across the entire cluster.

02 — All tokens revoked

Every connection token is invalidated. Total lockout — reconnection blocked until new tokens are issued.

03 — WebSocket connections killed

Active connections terminated via Redis pubsub broadcast. Propagates to every runtime node in the cluster.

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Real-World Applications

The Product Manager reviewing user calls

A PM finishes a day of five customer interviews. Instead of copying key pain points into a Notion document, they ask their agent: 'What were the top three complaints about our current dashboard UI?' The MCP uses `ask_fred` to cross-reference all five transcripts and immediately delivers a categorized list for the design team.

The Operations Lead keeping meeting records clean

An Ops lead realizes a critical project sync was poorly titled. They use `list_transcripts` to find the correct record, and then call `update_meeting_title` to rename it correctly, ensuring all team members know exactly what the documentation covers.

The Sales Team needing competitive intelligence

A sales rep records a demo call with a prospect. Before sending follow-up materials, they use `upload_audio` to process the raw recording and then ask their agent: 'What specific competitor did they mention by name?' The MCP extracts the exact product names mentioned.

The Manager onboarding a new employee

A manager needs to quickly bring a new hire up to speed on past project decisions. Instead of forwarding dozens of emails and notes, they ask their agent: 'Summarize the key launch dates for Project Phoenix.' The MCP scans multiple transcripts using `list_transcripts` and provides one concise summary.

Patterns to Avoid

Relying on human memory

X AVOID

Trying to remember who promised what during a fast-paced meeting, forcing you to send follow-up emails that are often incomplete or inaccurate.

✓ INSTEAD

After the call, use your AI client agent and ask it: 'What action items were assigned to me?' The MCP handles this using tools like ``ask_fred`` and gives you an immediate, verifiable list of commitments.

Scattering notes across platforms

X AVOID

Copying snippets of dialogue from Zoom into Slack, then summarizing them in Google Docs, resulting in inconsistent formatting and missing context.

✓ INSTEAD

Let your agent do the heavy lifting. After the meeting, simply use ``get_transcript`` to pull the single source of truth for all text, actions, and summaries.

Missing key participants

X AVOID

Scheduling a follow-up call but forgetting to invite a critical stakeholder because you couldn't recall their current team role or email address.

✓ INSTEAD

Before scheduling, use the ``list_team_users`` tool within your agent workflow. It provides the full directory data so you don't miss anyone.

The Right Fit

Use this MCP if your primary pain point is information retrieval from conversational media. You need to ask questions like 'Why did we choose X over Y?' and get an answer based on minutes or hours of recorded dialogue. This MCP shines when you need programmatic access to the *content* of meetings, not just a list of meeting names. Don't use this if all you need is basic cloud storage for audio files—a simple file-sharing solution works fine then. Also, don't use it if your goal is just to schedule the meeting; you still need a calendar tool for that. This MCP focuses solely on recording and analyzing what happened *after* or *during* the communication.

The endless cycle of note-taking and searching old calls.

Every week, you spend time in post-meeting cleanup. You open Zoom, Google Meet, or Teams recordings, hit play, then pause, rewind, and copy/paste key decisions into a document. Then you have to cross-reference who was speaking to figure out who owns the next task. It's manual, it's slow, and frankly, it drains your afternoon.
